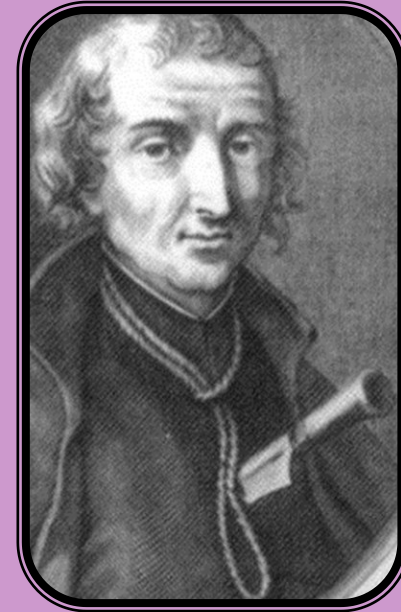

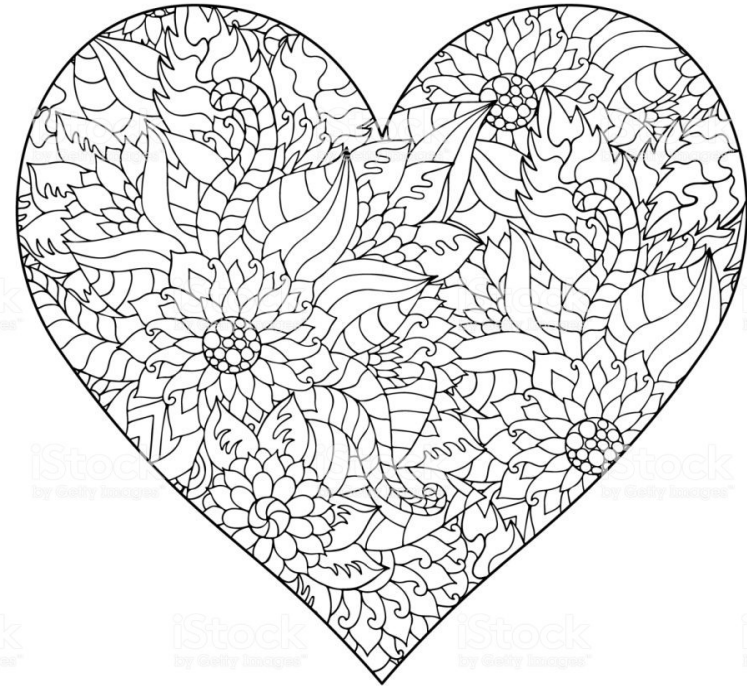
Siarad gyda adjectives – gyffrous, anhygoel, sbwriel, ddiflas a ddiddorol.
